Questions to Consider				
1.	Read Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8. What is our mission as believers in Jesus Christ?			
2.	Thinking about Acts 1:8 and the Christian life, how do we experience this power from the Holy Spirit, and what are some counterfeits to this power that we might rely on instead?			
3.	In practical terms, what does it look like for you to be a witness for Jesus Christ in your everyday life? Are there people or areas of life where this has been especially challenging?			
4.	Without looking at notes, what are the crucial elements of the gospel that you would ideally seek to communicate to an unbeliever?			
5.	Much of what we see in Acts is descriptive (describing conditions in the early church), and not prescriptive (specifically prescribing these things for all time). Looking at Acts 2:42-47, what parts of that description are prescribed elsewhere in the New Testament for local churches?			
6.	An attitude of generosity is clearly seen among the early believers, but where else in the New Testament might we look for instruction on giving to enable a local church to carry on ministry?
